1. West Point Golf Club

- West Point Golf Club has 120 Full Playing Members, plus an “Active Waitlist” who participate in club events while waiting to become members. A further “**Pending Waitlist**” will become Active WLers as space becomes available. This guide explains the “Pending Waitlist”.
- As a “senior men’s” club, members’ age range is 55 to the 90s, with widely varying handicaps. West Point members are very involved with the club, the average member playing 20 weeks each season. We play golf according to the rules, record scores and there are small prizes, but more important, we just enjoy playing golf. Camaraderie and friendship are a priority.
- West Point GC’s main playing season is 32 weeks every Thursday from April to October, primarily at Langara, McCleery and Fraserview. Each week, members pay their green fees to the City. The annual club membership fee (currently \$150) covers prizes and administration.

2. Membership and the Waitlists

- To be eligible for membership, prospective members must: be aged over 55; have or become able to hold a Handicap Index of 30 or less; and agree, when accepted into membership, to play at least 15 club games each year and participate regularly in Club social events.
- West Point has an opening for new applications once a year. Applicants join a Waitlist, moving to membership when space is available, usually about 12 new members each year.
- The club has become very over-subscribed, so there are now two waitlist divisions. About 15 golfers are on the “**Active Waitlist**” who take part in club events. See the Active Waitlister Guide for details. There is a \$50 annual fee for Active WLers.
- There is a second “**Pending Waitlist**” of golfers who do not participate in club events and do not pay any fees, but they have priority to join the Active WL when space becomes available.

3. The West Point GC Pending Waitlist

- New West Point applicants are added to the Pending Waitlist. A draw is held after the annual Waitlist Opening to determine each person’s priority on the Pending Waitlist. As a space on the Active Waitlist becomes available, the #1 on the Pending Waitlist will be invited to join the Active Waitlist, and so on through #2, #3 etc., etc. Future additions to the Pending Waitlist will be added below those now on the Pending Waitlist.
- The club will maintain and publish the Pending Waitlist on the club website, so listees can see their priority progress. Because the club is so over-subscribed, please be aware that the waiting period for admission can be long. Typically, people will be on the Active Waitlist for a year, while the Pending Waitlist can be one to two years on top of that.
- Please advise the club of changes in contact information, or if you decide to withdraw. The contact is the Membership Director, whose name and contact info are on the club website.
